This is an ADGA Sanctioned JR Doe Show and SR Doe Show, and their rules shall govern.

- 1 Base date for computing age is the show date.
- 2 The original registration certificate is required for all does over 6 months of age, and should be shown to the show secretary during check-in time, before the day's activities begin. Under 6 months stamped duplicate accepted.
- 3 Sr. Does should be in their pens no later than 8:00 am Saturday. Sr. Does may start arriving Friday evening between 7 pm -10 pm. Jr. Does should be in their pens no later than 9:00 am Sunday. All animals will be subject to veterinary inspection prior to the show. No abscesses, ringworm or other contagious diseases will be allowed. No junior animals will be allowed to leave until 6:00pm Sunday otherwise premiums will be forfeited.
- 4 There is no pre-show milk out.
- 5 Sr. Show will start at 10:00 am Sat. The 4-H show will be held first followed by the open show. Show order will be Alpines, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Sable, Toggenburg, and Recorded Grade. Junior Show will start at 11:00 am Sunday in the same order
- 6 Entry fee will be \$3.50. Group classes have no entry fee. Pen Space may be limited. Entries will be accepted until the barn is full. Premiums limited to 2 per class, per breed, per exhibitor. Groups are limited to 1 per class, per breed, per exhibitor. All animals must be shown in regular classes to qualify for groups.
- 7 Grand & Reserve Champions, Best of Breed, & Best Doe in show receive ADGA Rosettes.
Premiums: \$8.00, \$7.00, \$6.00, \$5.00, \$4.00
Groups: \$10.00, \$8.00, \$6.00

Junior Division: consists of does under 24 months of age that have never freshened.

Senior Division: consists of does 12 months of age or over that have freshened or are in milk, this includes dry milkers.

All exhibitors **must clean out** their pens before leaving Sunday night or premiums will be forfeited.
