RULES:

1. These shows are sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Assn and their rules shall govern. Only American Dairy Goat Assn., American Goat Society and Canadian Goat Society registered, recorded or applied-for animals that are recognized by ADGA as dairy animals, may be shown in official American Dairy Goat Shows. The Junior and Senior Shows are separately sanctioned.
2. These shows are sanctioned for the following breeds: Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Saanen, Oberhasli, Toggenburg and Recorded Grades.
3. **The order of the show is subject to change**
4. The original registration or recordation certificate is required for all animals six month of age or older. The original registration, recordation certificate or duplicate application stamped by the registry office is required for all animals under six months of age. A stamped duplicate is valid for 30 days from the ADGA office dated on it. This must be shown to the show secretary prior to the start of the show. No copies of registration, recordation certificate or stamped duplicate applications, telegrams, or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original documents. All names included on one identification number constitute only one membership; therefore, only one exhibitor. Only the ID number on the registration/recordation certificate or on the stamped duplication application is proof of ownership.

6. The base date to determine the age of an animal is 5/25/19 for Junior does and 5/26/19 for Senior does.
7. Animals with natural horns shall not be shown. No health papers are required for Minnesota animals; however, any animal is subject to rejection for unhealthy conditions at the discretion of the show committee and the show vet. We will follow the ADGA policy on abscesses which does not allow showing an animal with an abscess that is balding or draining. A vet will be at the show to check health papers and the animals. All out-of-state animals must be accompanied by an interstate health certificate/certificate of veterinary inspection. Scrapies herd identification must be presented at time of check in /veterinary inspection in order to show.
8. **All junior does must be in place by Noon on Saturday and checked in with the show secretary. If coming only for the Senior Doe Show on Sunday, animals must be in place by 7 am. NO PEN GUARANTEES IF COMING FOR SUNDAY ONLY- PLAN TO SHOW OUT OF YOUR TRAILER.**
9. Saturday shows start at 2:00 pm with junior doe shows and Sunday at 8 am will be senior doe shows.
10. Animals may start arriving anytime after 4 pm on Friday the 24th.

11. Check-in will start Friday night, and continue until Noon on Saturday.
12. Entry fees: \$4 per head per show. All animals entered (name, class, DOB, owner) after Noon on May 20th will be \$6.00 per head per show.
13. There will be no pre-show milk out. All milk must be taken home or disposed of properly in marked barrels provided; **NO DUMPING!**
14. There will be a \$5.00 pen fee for the pens in the swine barn, and \$10 for the pens in the Horse and cattle barns. Small pens roughly 5X5, and large pens 10X10 or larger.
15. All pens must be cleaned by exhibitor before leaving, and manure taken to designated dumping spots.
16. Proper show attire is black or white trousers or skirts and white shirt.
17. There will be a food stand available on Saturday. There will be a free will donation breakfast on Saturday and Sunday morning.
18. Saturday night after the completion of the junior doe show there will be a catered meal on the grounds, along with the spring MDGA general membership meeting taking place at the same time. Meal will include: hamburgers, pork loin sandwiches, sides, dessert, and beverages.
19. Saturday evening meal count is needed by **May 17th**. Please mark your meal choices when submitting entries. **If not able to submit entries by May 17th, please call/text/email Casey Prochniak (507-217-7229) or caseyahlbrecht@hotmail.com with meal count.**
20. Toggenburg Specialty will be held in ring 1.

Youth Show and Youth Showmanship

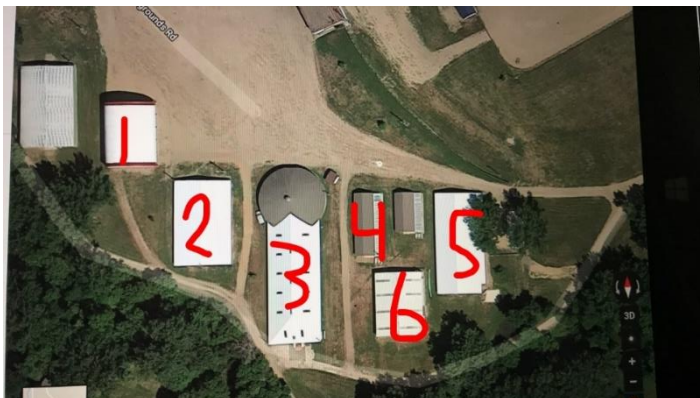
See Youth Show Rules and sign up guidelines. Individual goat classes will have a reduced fee and showmanship classes will be FREE of charge.
